





Amid Hong Kong's crowded canyon of towering skyscrapers, a good view is increasingly hard to find. Which explains why Sevva has been making a splash as much for its panoramic sweep of Hong Kong harbour from its penthouse terrace as for its eclectic Western and Asian menu. For the interiors, socialite owner Bonnie Gokson recruited family friend Calvin Tsao. The architect has cleverly allowed the view to dominate by dividing the sprawling 25th floor penthouse into intimate dining zones. From the glass-walled foyer through to the spare vaulted main dining room framed by a green wall, each space is a carefully orchestrated shift of moods and décor. Equally, Gokson has kept the menu simple and wholesome with chemical-free La Ionica chicken and chewy Poilâne bread. On offer are standards like clay pot rice, though it's the more unusual dishes such as Wagyu beef cheek and ox tongue pot pie served with porcini fries that are keeping diners happy.
